*REX the dog wags his tail happily, crumbs still on his nose.*

Rex! You silly dog! You ate our cookies!

**BEN:**

Ha! Mystery solved. Let's ask Mom if we can have two more, and this time we will put the plate somewhere Rex can't reach.

**DAISY:**

Good idea. Sorry, Rex, no more cookies for you today!
